






Wales has achieved the **64%** recycling target for 2019-20.



Net expenditure on Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)





Net expenditure on household waste accounts for 96% of the total MSW net expenditure.







Household waste collection and treatment expenditure 2019-20

Waste service costs per household



Household waste services in Wales - Regional









Net expenditure on treatment
